### Main menu, Tooltips and Tabs do not display Hotkeys

<b>Description</b>			
The hotkeys are missing from the display of these items.			
Display of Hotkeys on tabs and the top level menu is of <b>low</b> priority if each has a tooltip.			
Display of Hotkeys on tooltips is of high priority. This is how users normally learn the hotkeys.			
All main menus must have a hotkey (hormally Alt+<first letter>). This is high priority.			
As described elsewhere, the context menu must be available either by a hotkey or it should appear as a top level menu (or both).
