For example when adds a link from youtube which sets customised packagename within plugin settings. They then have to edit generic rule to ignore rule youtube links. They effectively need todo that for every decrypter plugin that sets packagename. This feature would allow quick ease to ignore generic package customiser rules without the need to set ignores based on source.</p> <p>This feature should still work in well with current implementation of the add links dialog to ignore package customiser.
