<p>Although there's this line in the DownloadsPanel class in onShow():</p> <pre>table.requestFocusInWindow();</pre> <p>the downloads table is not focussed on start-up. According to my research, DownloadsPanel.onShow() never gets called. It is called when setShow() is called. (See View.setContent() to see why setShow() is not called.)</p> <p>I tried calling requestFocusInWindow() in JDGui.internalInitLocationAndDimension() after</p> <pre>WindowManager.getInstance().setVisible(mainFrame, true, FrameState.OS_DEFAULT);</pre> <p>but this still doesn't work. The only thing I got to work was the following (at the location previously mentioned):</p> <pre>new DelayedRunnable(5000) {     @Override     public void delayedrun() {         ((DownloadsPanel)MainTabbedPane.getInstance().getSelectedView().getContent()).getTable().requestFocusInWindow();     } }.resetAndStart();</pre> <p>(There's some delay with the menu bar and tool bar happening until the GUI is fully loaded. Obviously, requestFocusInWindow() only has effect thereafter.)</p> <p>OS: Windows 8.1</p>
