Current status: Add archives --> this is what can happen: a.01 a.02 a.03 b.01 b.02 b.03			
<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. a + b is both incomplete (all online)</li><li>2. a is complete, b is incomplete (some online)</li><li>3. a + b is both incomplete (all offline)</li></ol>			
Case 3 is relatively obvious as you will easily see that you just added 100% offline URLs to the linkgrabber.			
For cases 1 and 2, you will only get the "incomplete" message once you finally want to download --> To me, this is too late. Why not add an indicator: Case 1 = Package gets color green Case 2 = Package gets color orange Case 3 = Package gets color red			
Maybe also with settings to: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Activate this feature</li><li>2. Deactivate this feature</li><li>3. Activate only for archives (I believe, sometimes videos are also treated as archives --&gt; But maybe that is simply a bug which needs to be fixed)</li></ol>
